Walker and runners of all ages are welcome to participate. The registration cost is \$50 for adults and \$25 for those under 18 years of age, and includes a t-shirt, a structured training program including a weekly group walk or run, a post race party, and a personal giving page on our website. While there is no fundraising requirement to participate, Hope Connections encourages team members to help raise funds from their friends and families to support Hope Connections' free programs for those with cancer and their loved ones. Training begins the Saturday after Labor Day.
